Along with this interest it is also possible, certainly in the larger and newer marinas, to get Wi-Fi in the harbours. In some marinas this is free but, generally, one has to sign up with the supplier of the facility and fees can vary widely.

Add second paragraph:

As of 1st December 2010 a modification was made to the regulations for the Gibraltar Separation Zone. Vessels greater than 50m in length must make a report (GIBREP) to Tangier or Ceuta when they cross longitudes 5°58'W and 5°15'W. However if your craft is less than 50m, not carrying hazardous cargo or fishing then there is no requirement to file a GIBREP when crossing the above longitudes.

## New marina construction and Facilities

Delete and replace with:

### New Marina construction

The new 800-berth marina was opened in August 2010 with all piers and jetties in place but with very limited shoreside facilities. The Torre de Control is built on the western pier and there is also an auxiliary building providing male and female changing rooms, showers and toilets and a washer and dryer for laundry. It is hoped to have further buildings available by the 2011 season. The Club Maritimo Linense will remain with its moorings on Puerto Chico jetty but it is strictly private with no space for visitors. One is allowed, however, to use the restaurant in the club.

It has been reported that the arrival pontoon is quite high with widely spaced bollards – more suited to superyachts. Also the fuel berth had no easy mooring facilities for the smaller cruising yacht.

### Entrance

This is very easy as one simply rounds the end of the breakwater and heads for the anchorage or marina.

### Anchorage

Initially anchoring was actively discouraged in the harbour as it would interfere with the proposed RoRo turning circle. However it now seems the RoRo is not coming to La Linea and the SW corner of the harbour may be available for anchoring. The fact is that with the tensions in this area, there is no certainty of anything! Sometimes the Spanish Guardia come around and have cleared out the yachts, telling them to go into the new marina – which is undersubscribed. Other times, they leave them alone. Note that the anchorage is not controlled by the marina. Many of the yachts using the anchorage were using the local yacht club to dinghy ashore. The yacht club make a €5 charge per day for this facility but you then have use of showers, Wi-Fi, etc. as well as secure place for the dinghy.

### Facilities

At present there is only limited facilities for the visiting yachtsman but the new marina will have power, water, Wi-Fi and TV on the berths and chandlers etc. are planned. There is a large produce market and supermarket in La Linea and Gibraltar is well within walking distance but note it is necessary to show one's passport to cross the border.
