NIEUWPOORT

Entrance

Add: Nieuwpoort Firing Range: Take account of the artillery practice firing range just to the E of the port entrance at Lombarsijde. The Nieuwpoort firing range will NOT be active on any Saturday, Sunday or bank holiday. For the rest of this season it will not be active until 17 September, will cease operations from 28 October to 5 November and over the Christmas and New Year period. The firing range can be contacted on VHF 67 Sector Lombardsijde.

A board on the starboard side when exiting the harbour tells when the range is active. There's a guard boat also on watch close to the entrance when the range is live. Firing can take place in three sectors: small, intermediate and large, and will determine the detour you have to make. It's always good to call the range officer, in many cases you can negotiate free passage. They always take a break at noon and close quite early in the afternoon.
