When Tower on abandoned hotel bears 128° Mag, alter course to the left to 171° Mag, so as to pass 3.0m to east of red buoy, thence head towards Gazebo on bearing of 180° Mag with the following:

Once south of the mid coral formation, immediately come to a course of 128° Mag for about 50 yards, then head for the Gazebo on a course of 180° Mag eyeballing your way between two shoal spots. (ILNW 471/10)

COTTON VALLEY CUT TO TEAGUE BAY

Replace: This gap in the coral is usually marked by two small red-and-black buoys (privately maintained by the St Croix Yacht Club).

TEAGUE BAY, MAIN ENTRANCE Add new section below:

BUCK ISLAND

Visiting yachts must obtain a permit to visit Buck island. These are available from the National Park Service visitor contact station at Christiansted. (ILNW 166/13)

CHRISTIANSTED HARBOUR

First paragraph, replace line starting: "Coming into the harbour,..." with:

Head for the heavily overgrown Fort Louise Augusta, with two small radio masts on the point, on 177° mag. (ILNW 287/15)

BUCK ISLAND

Add to end of new section: Officially permits take 3 to 5 working days to be issued. However, if you point out that your stay in St Croix is only three days you will, with luck, have the permit issued in one day. (ILNW 289/15)

CHRISTIANSTED HARBOUR

Add new paragraph to end of section: Daylight dinghy theft is becoming a problem in Christiansted. When tying a dinghy to the walkway in town, be sure to lock it up. (ILNW 290/15)
